Directions: Take US 50 east toward Annapolis. Take Exit #22 (Rt. 665/Aris T Allen Blvd.). Go right at the first light (Forest Drive). Stay on Forest Drive for roughly three miles (and nine lights) until you come to the sign marking the Bay Ridge Community. Take the first right, which will put you on to Herndon Avenue. The Bay Ridge Pool and parking are a 1/4-mile on the right. Overflow parking will be at the Chesapeake Bay Foundation. The entrance to that is 200 meters before the entrance to Bay Ridge Pool.

Schedule of Events:

Check in begins: 7:30 AM (all swimmers must check in at least 30 minutes before the start of their race)

Briefing: 8:00 AM

10 & Under 1 K – 9:00 am

11-12 and 13-14 2 K – 9:45 am

15-18 3 K – 10:30 am

(Men and women in each age group will compete on the same course at the same time.)

If there are a high number of entries in a particular event, the race will be run in heats. If the number of entries for a particular event is so large to cause it to run more than the time allotted above, the meet director will limit the entries for that event.

Weather Delay: If inclement weather causes a delay, a notice will be posted on the Naval Academy Aquatic Club's website (www.naac.ws) along with the adjusted start times for each race. There will be no rain date.

Facilities: The swimmers will compete in an area of the Chesapeake Bay adjacent to the Bay Ridge Community in Annapolis. The racecourse will be marked with large orange buoys. The start will take place on a beach in front of the Bay Ridge Pool. The pool includes a clubhouse, which will be open for swimmers to change and shower.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Each swimmer must be a 2010 USA Swimming registered athlete in one of the LSC's which make up the Eastern Zone
2. Each swimmer must be entered on the official entry forms provided. Only one swimmer per entry form.
3. Competition is restricted to Eastern Zone LSC's.
4. The Meet Director reserves the right to limit entries or conduct the events in heats
5. A full refund will be given to swimmers that are eliminated.

COURSE: **10 & U course is 250m x 250m. 11-12 & 13-14 course is 750m x 250m and the 15-18 course is 1,250m x 250m.** Each race distance will have course bouys every 250m and turn bouys that will be clearly marked. A beach Start and Finish will be used. The Chesapeake Bay off Bay Ridge is mostly a sandy bottom, shallow, salt water area (average water depth of 5-8 feet), with little or no current, which may be influenced by wind conditions. Water temperature in August is usually between 76-80 degrees

RULES: 2010 USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will govern this event. No drafting allowed. No swimmer shall be allowed to use or wear any device that may be an aid to his/her speed, endurance or buoyancy.

Wet suits, flotation aids or any similar items, and anything used to maintain body heat, except a reasonable application of body grease, are not allowed.

PROTESTS: A Meet Jury will adjudicate any protest including issues of conduct which may occur at the meet venue. All protests must be made in writing. The Meet Jury will consist of the Meet Director, Meet Referee, an Athlete Representative, a Coach Representative and a Non-coach Representative

Safety: Adequate safety guidelines will be strictly adhered to at this meet. Kayakers will be spotting throughout the course and safety craft will be on site and prepared to administer aid should the need arise. The Fire Department Search & Rescue will be the Safety Authority on the water, and the Coast Guard will monitor the surrounding area in order to keep boat traffic off the course. Meet swim caps will be provided and must be worn by all competitors.

AWARDS: Zone Open Water medals for first through eighth places. Please Note: The results of the Open Water Competition will not affect the team score from the Eastern Zones Meet.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries must be received by Wednesday August 4, 2010. All entries must be submitted on the official entry form. Please submit a separate entry sheet for each swimmer. All signatures, including coach's verification, must be on the entry form prior to participation

Swimmers entering a meet must be registered with USA Swimming by the meet entry deadline date. Per Maryland Swimming rules, any club that enters an unregistered athlete will be fined \$100.00 per unregistered athlete.

Release Form: Coaches are encouraged to include a completed release form (copy follows) for each swimmer when mailing the entry fee check. The Meet Director must have a completed release form for each swimmer no later than 8:00 am the day of the meet.
